WHAT IS TRUTH?

GREEK: ἀλήθεια (*alētheia*). n. fem. **truth**, **true**, **sincerity**, **integrity**. Indicates the quality or state of being **real or genuine**—often in the sense of visible and verifiable reality, demonstrated by facts, actual events, or proven character.[1]

Meanings of "Truth":

- 1.The revelation of God in Christ and in Scripture (John 8:31–36; 14:6)
- 2.Sincerity, integrity, genuineness (Ps. 51:6; Col.3:9; Eph. 4:25)



The Righteous Reign of the Branch


